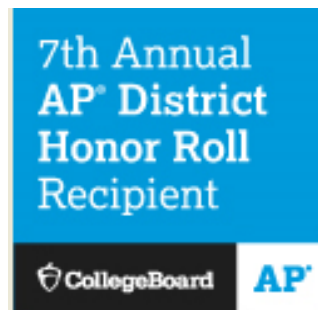

### **February 7 - 11 Student course selection:**

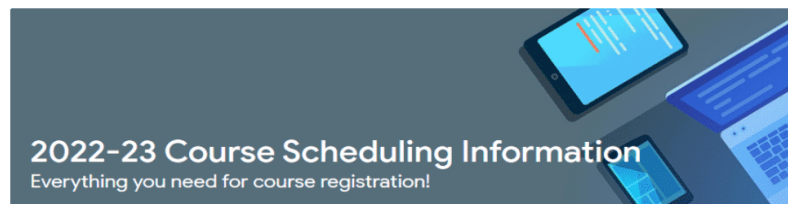

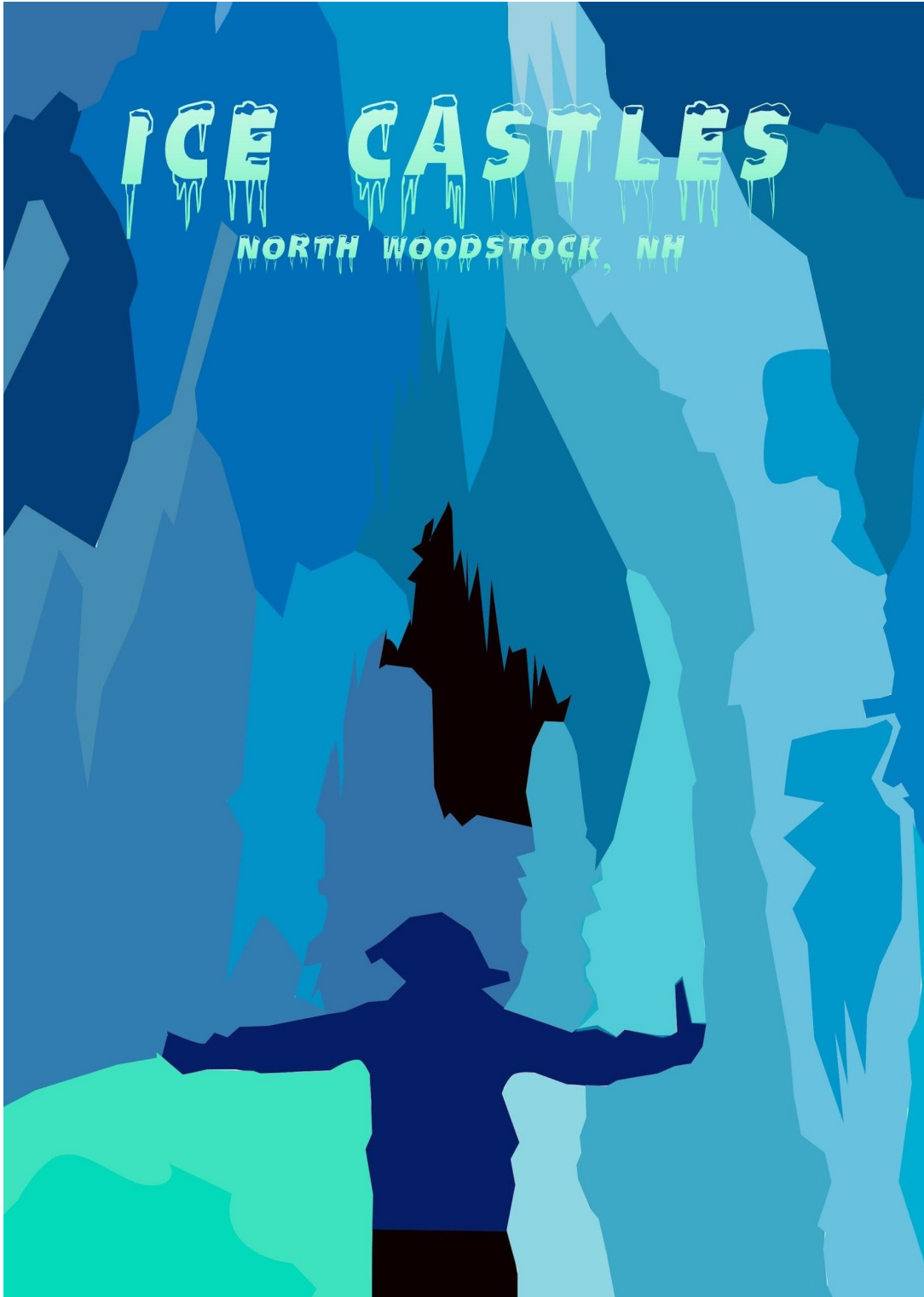

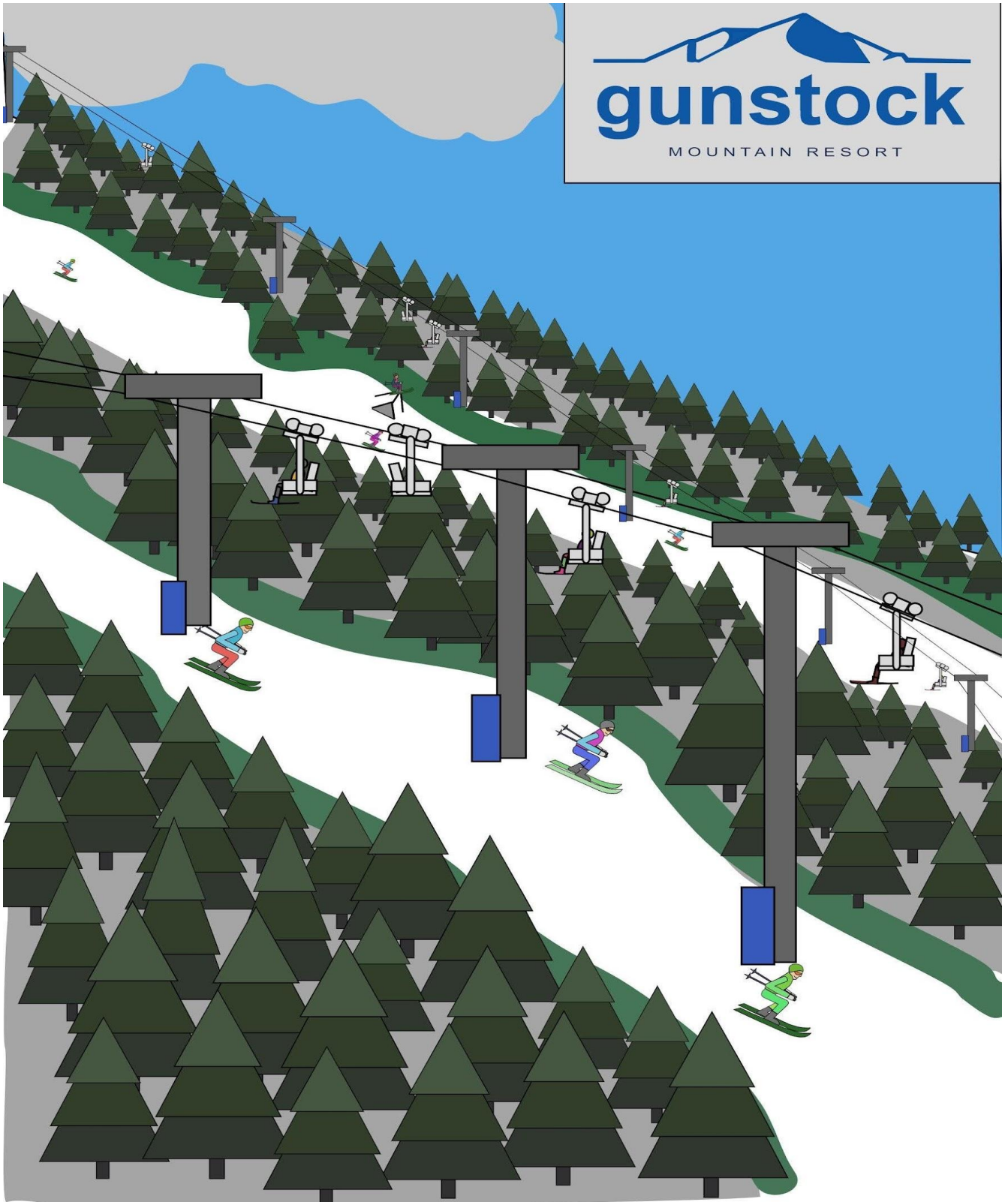

# PROTECT YOUNG EYES

Things have changed dramatically since we were kids. Social media is a new language altogether and it is evolving on a daily basis. It started with simply messaging and the sharing of images to creating video content and developing new forms of communication altogether. In fact, some social media platforms are attempting to develop a new virtual world called the Metaverse. There is a lot of research to indicate the dangers, as well as the benefits, of social media, and there are still a lot of unknowns as to the long term impact social media will have on all of us. With that said, it is important for educators and parents to be informed on such topics and to remain current with what children are accessing on their mobile devices.

At our most recent Emergency Planning Committee meeting, we discussed with the Gilford Police Department's SRO, Officer Raxter, ways we can remain informed of new social media applications and happenings. 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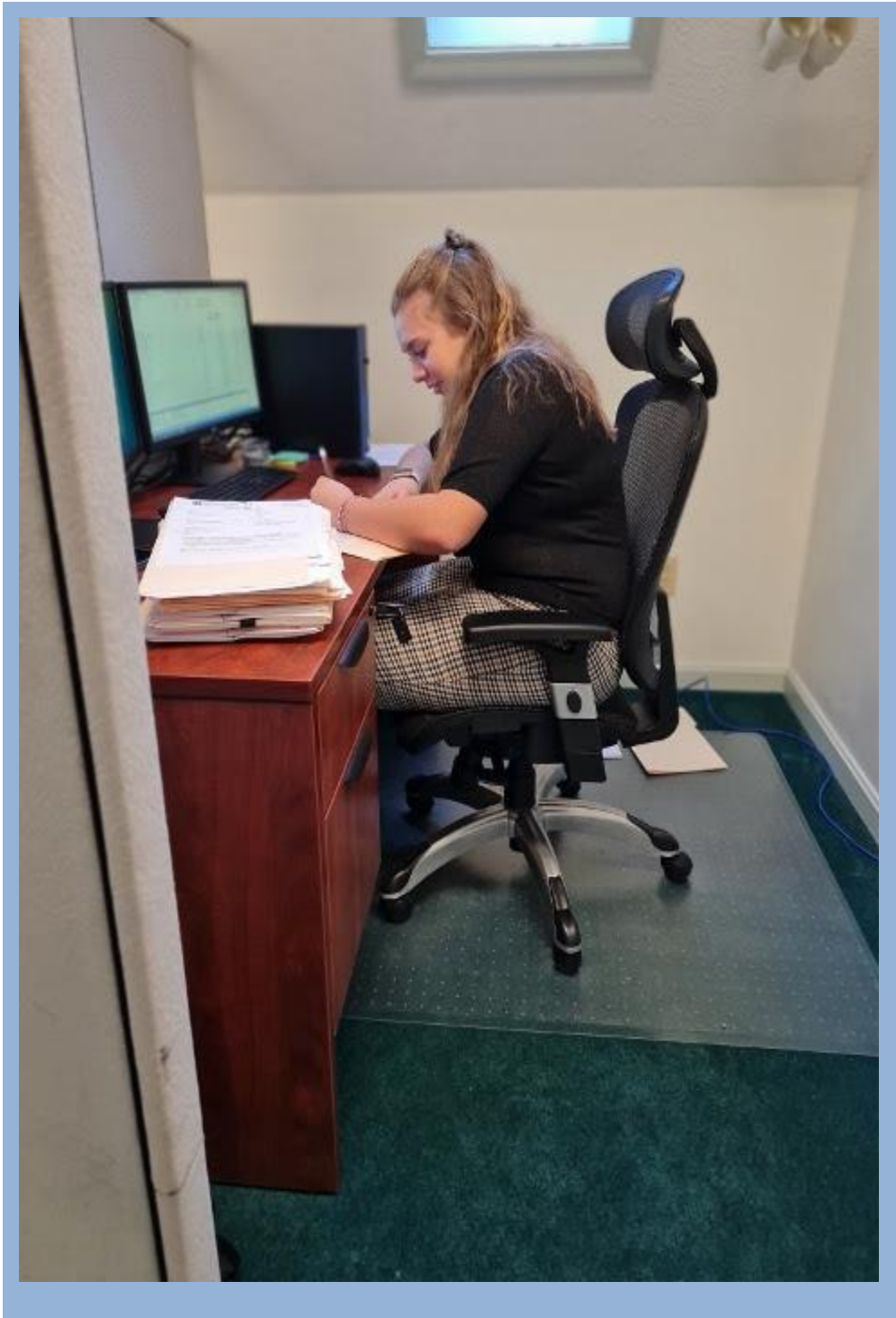
