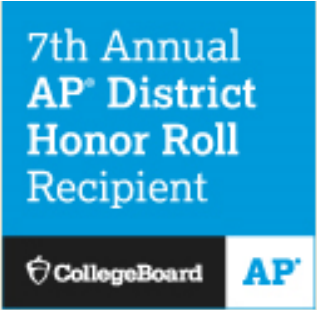
Hello Learners and Parents,

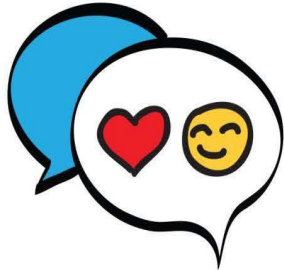
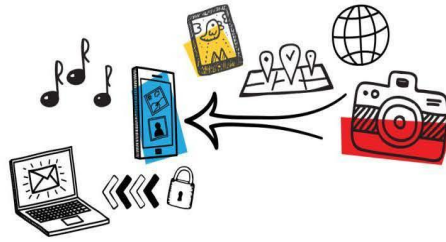

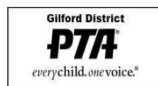

Final Exams
