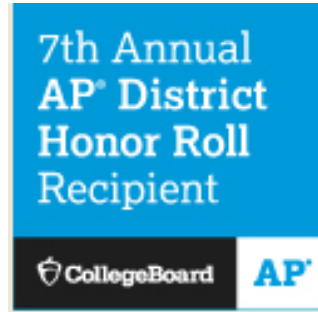

On Saturday, March 12 students visited the Capitol Building in Concord to participate in the Youth and Government pre-legislative assembly. Students were trained in their assigned government roles to prepare for their two-day mock legislative experience in April. Alison Kenyon ran for Senate President and although she did not win the position, she was assigned to be the chair of the Senate Ways and Means committee. Lily Tierno was introduced to her role as a Supreme Court Justice and learned more about the judicial system with fellow student justices and student lawyers. Christine Pingol, Chair of the Health and Human Services Committee, participated in a mock bill debate along with other House members. Aidan Miller trained with an actual lobbyist to prepare for his role.

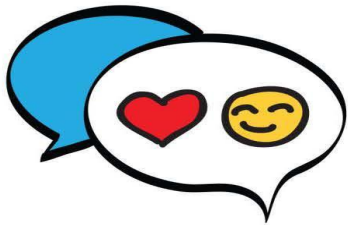
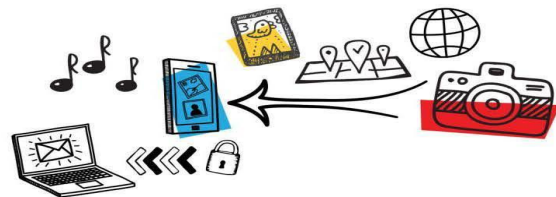

The Gilford School District has received \$1,246,509.89 as our allocation for the ARP ESSER III grant. These grant funds are available to the local school district until September 30, 2024. Twenty percent of the ARP ESSER III funds must be set aside to address learning loss. For the Gilford School District we must set aside \$249,302.00 to address learning loss.

The remaining funds are intended to assist school districts in response to COVID-19. Some of those items may include instructional technology, protective equipment, cleaning supplies, air exchange or ventilation systems, social and emotional learning, staffing and supporting academic growth.

We are currently in the process of developing priorities for the ARP ESSER III grant. If you are interested in providing input or suggestions regarding the use of ARP ESSER III funds, please submit information to esser@sau73.org. Thank you for your help.

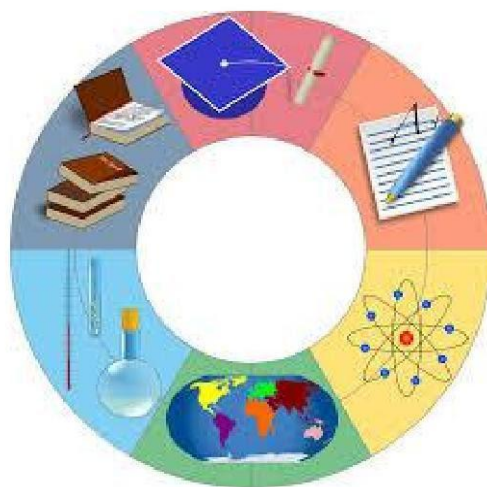
