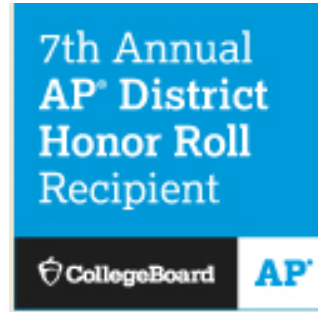


Hello Learners and Parents,

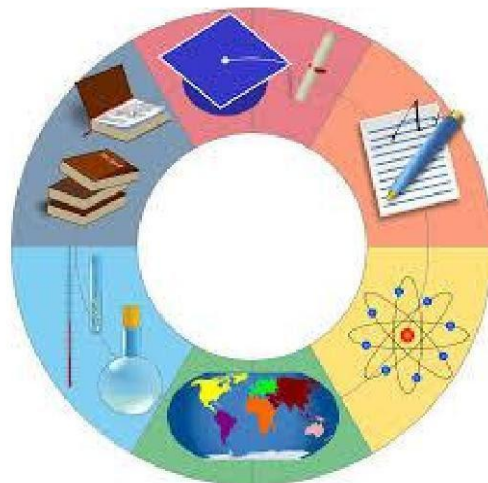
