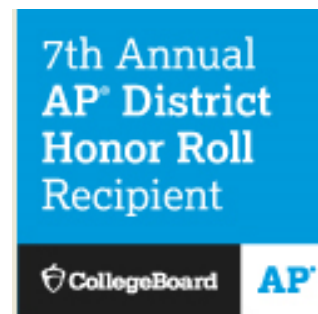

GHS ALICE lockdown **DRILL, Monday June 13, will begin at
8:00am**

Monday's ALICE lockdown **drill** will begin at 8:00. Students and staff will practice a scenario with staff members leading them through this experience. In collaboration with Gilford Police and Fire, the high

school administrative team will conduct an ALICE lockdown drill to ensure that students and staff members stay current with best practices such as the [ALICE training](#) that we adopted four years ago.

An enhanced feature is the addition of the "escape" factor. Classes will have the option of reacting and then "escaping" and walking to the Gilford Community Center. We also are adding a parent reunification component this time. Those parents were contacted and we thank them for their time. The drill should take about 15-20 minutes. At that point, staff members will debrief with their students.

The students and staff at GHS are our number one priority and I thank you for placing your trust in us. Please contact me if you have any questions.
