THE SCHOOL

Gilford High School, accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges, is a comprehensive public school housing grades 9 through 12, servicing the towns of Gilford and Gilmanton. Gilmanton, New Hampshire, is predominantly rural and has two village areas, The Corners and The Iron Works. Gilford, New Hampshire, is a rural residential community located on the southwest shore of Lake Winnepesaukee, approximately 25 miles north of Concord.

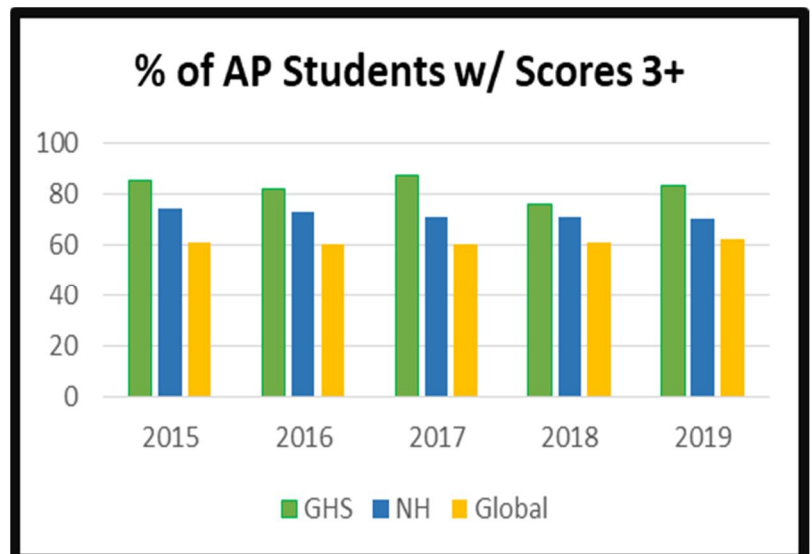
