

THE SCHOOL

Gilford High School, accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges, is a comprehensive public school housing grades 9 through 12, servicing the towns of Gilford and Gilmanton. Gilmanton, New Hampshire, is predominantly rural and has two village areas, The Corners and The Iron Works. Gilford, New Hampshire, is a rural residential community located on the southwest shore of Lake Winnipesaukee, approximately 25 miles north of Concord.

The mission of Gilford High School, in partnership with our communities, is to engage each student actively in a broad range of educational opportunities that will equip all students to be lifelong learners and responsible citizens who have the abilities necessary to thrive in a changing society.

CURRICULUM

In addition, students are offered courses at Huot Technical Center, Winnisquam Agriculture Center, online courses (VLACS) to include E-Start College Courses, Extended Learning Opportunities, Independent Studies, Running Start, and Early College Start courses in conjunction with Lakes Region Community College. Gilford High School is on a trimester schedule. Our students enroll in up to 5 courses per trimester.


